# NEED HELP STARTING OVER CLEAN?



**Now, you might be eligible for the Supplemental  
Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)  
(Formerly Food Stamps)  
even if you had a drug-related felony conviction:**

IF you completed qualified alcohol or drug treatment

OR

IF a qualified treatment provider told the food stamp office  
you did not need treatment

OR

IF you sought help from a qualified provider who had no  
room for you and you were placed on a waiting list.



**The Department of Human Services (DHS)  
will have a list of Qualified Providers.**

# WHERE IS YOUR LOCAL DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES?

You may call or go to the local Department of Human Services (DHS) in your county (sometimes called the "welfare office") for more information.

In some counties they will only be able to set up a date to interview you.

They will send you a letter notifying you when your interview is and what to bring to the interview.

**Do not skip the interview.**

If you cannot make the interview call the DHS office and reschedule, as soon as you know. Listed on this page is the address, telephone number and fax number of the DHS Offices in the West Tennessee area.
